FEATHER QUEST

MAY 29, 30 & 31

The Laurel Highlands area is a birder's paradise. During this two day, two night eco tour we will explore what the Laurel Highlands has to offer for birding enthusiasts. Our trip will be lead by renowned birder Chuck

Tague and will take us from Ohiopyle State Park to Powdermill Nature Reserve's bird banding station and many stops along the way. All levels of birding experience are encouraged to participate. The trip includes



two nights accommodation at Ohiopyle State Park, guide service, food, and all shuttles for two days.

COST: \$155-\$180 per person based on accommodation type and double occupancy

KEELS, HEELS & WHEELS

AUGUST 14, 15 & 16

Explore Ohiopyle and Laurel Hill State Parks on this two day two night ecotour. We will bike, boat and hike our way through the Laurel Highlands. Activities include a moonlight canoe on Laurel Hill Lake, an interpretive bike trip on the Youghiogheny River Trail, 2 hikes in state park Natural Areas, a tour and tasting at a local winery, and a 9 mile boat trip on the Middle Youghiogheny (class II water). All food, equipment rentals, overnight accommodations, shuttles and guide services are included in the package. This trip is not for couch potatoes!
